

### **TOOLS**

Many beginners often struggle with choosing the right tools. We will take the time to explain the different types of tablets available.



### **DISPLAY TABLETS**

Display tablet, also known as a pen display or drawing display, is a type of tablet that features a built-in screen. This screen allows users to draw directly onto it, providing a more natural and intuitive drawing experience similar to working on paper.



### **NON-DISPLAY TABLETS**

Display tablet, also known as a pen display or A "non-display tablet," also known as a pen tablet or screenless tablet, is a computer input device that allows users to draw, sketch, or write with a stylus, but unlike a display tablet, it does not have its own built-in screen.



### STANDALONE TABLETS

A standalone drawing tablet is a self-contained digital art device that combines a screen, computer, and drawing functionalities into a single unit, eliminating the need for a separate computer connection. e.g iPad

### ILLUSTRATION ROLES

#### What roles can I apply for as a Digital Illustrator?

Here's a compiled list of roles you can pursue as a digital illustrator.

#### **CONCEPT ART**

Concept artists create the initial visual representation of ideas for various media, such as video games, films, and animations. They design characters, environments, props, and creatures to bring a project's vision to life before it enters the production phase.

#### CHARACTER DESIGN

Character designers focus on developing and creating visual representations of characters for animation, comics, video games, or other forms of media. This includes considering the character's personality, background, and role within the story, as well as their appearance, clothing, and expressions.

#### **BOOK ILLUSTRATIONS**

Illustrators who specialize in book illustrations create images that complement and enhance the storytelling in both children's books and novels. They bring scenes, characters, and settings to life in a way that visually engages readers and strengthens the narrative.

#### **COMIC BOOK ART**

Comic book illustrators create the artwork for comic strips, graphic novels, and webcomics. This includes designing characters, backgrounds, panel layouts, and other visual elements to accompany the dialogue and plot.

#### **ADVERTISING AND MARKETING ILLUSTRATIONS**

Illustrators are often hired to create visuals that promote products or services. These illustrations can be used in print ads, billboards, social media campaigns, and website banners, designed to catch the eye and communicate key messages to the audience.

#### **EDITORIAL ILLUSTRATIONS**

Editorial illustrators create images that accompany articles, blog posts, magazines, and newspapers. The illustrations help convey the article's tone or subject matter visually, sometimes adding humor, insight, or emphasis to a particular point being made.

#### PACKAGING DESIGN

Digital illustrators working in packaging design create the artwork for product packaging. This can include designing labels, boxes, and containers with visually appealing elements that attract customers and effectively communicate the product's purpose or brand identity.

#### **GAME ART**

Game artists specialize in creating visual assets for video games. This includes 2D assets like characters, environments, and user interface elements. Digital illustrators working in the game industry may also create concept art, character designs, and assets used in game levels.

#### APP AND WEBSITE DESIGN

Some illustrators focus on the design of interfaces for apps and websites. They may create icons, buttons, and background visuals, making the digital experience more user-friendly and visually appealing. Their role is essential for ensuring that the user interface (UI) is not only functional but also visually engaging.

#### STORYBOARD ARTIST

Storyboard artists work with directors and producers to visually plan out scenes for movies, TV shows, or animations. They create illustrations that represent key moments or sequences in a production, helping guide the overall direction and flow of the visual storytelling.

#### **FASHION ILLUSTRATION**

Fashion illustrators specialize in drawing clothing, accessories, and fashion designs. They often work closely with designers to present new collections, design concepts, or visualizations of fashion ideas before they're produced for retail.

#### ARCHITECTURAL VISUALIZATION

Architectural illustrators create detailed, realistic visualizations of building designs. These may be used for architectural proposals, marketing materials, or client presentations, helping to showcase the aesthetic and functional qualities of a building or space before it's constructed.

#### **PRINT DESIGN**

Illustrators working in print design create artwork for a variety of printed materials, such as posters, brochures, flyers, and magazines. The role involves ensuring that illustrations align with the brand's messaging and capture the attention of readers.

#### **3D ILLUSTRATION AND VISUALIZATION**

3D illustrators work in a digital environment to create three-dimensional images or models. This can be applied to product visualizations, game assets, or character design for films and animations. These illustrators may use 3D modeling software to craft realistic or stylized visuals.

#### PRODUCT DESIGN

Digital illustrators working in product design create visual concepts and mock-ups for new products. They may design everything from tech gadgets to furniture, focusing on aesthetics, usability, and how a product will appeal to its target market.

#### SOCIAL MEDIA CONTENT CREATION

Illustrators working in social media create engaging content for brands, influencers, or companies. They design eye-catching images, gifs, and infographics to help increase engagement on various social platforms.

#### MOTION GRAPHICS AND ANIMATION

Digital illustrators skilled in motion graphics may create animated visuals, illustrations, and special effects for films, TV, online media, or advertising. These designs are often created frame-by-frame or through software to create a sense of movement.

#### **ALBUM ART AND MUSIC VISUALS**

Illustrators create the visual representations of music, whether it's album covers, promotional material, or visuals for music videos. These illustrations are meant to convey the artist's message, tone, or aesthetic.

#### VIRTUAL REALITY (VR) ART

Some digital illustrators specialize in creating assets for virtual reality experiences. They design immersive environments, objects, and characters that will be used within virtual worlds, often requiring a deep understanding of spatial design.
